Shipping Events (Logistics)

Prompt 74 and 79 42020	Prompt 74 (SO Loading) and Prompt 79 (SE Loading) will now prevent packing lines from different sales orders from being packed into the same carton if that carton is not a top level carton. If an item has been loaded into a carton, only line items from the same SO# can be loaded into that carton. In Prompt 74, users will see a 'Carton linked to another SO' message when attempting to load items from a different SO into an existing carton that has already been linked to another SO. In Prompt 79, users will see an 'OC SO mismatch' message when trying to load items into an existing carton that is already linked to a different SO. This new logic is available with VTERM version 812 or higher.
